



TELL ME A STORY

Communication and Language/Literacy

- *Take turns to speak and listen.
- *Speak in full sentences.
- *Listen to and retell the story 'There is a Tribe of Kids'.
- *Practise letter sounds and actions e.g. h, b, f, l
- *Continue to blend and segment CVC words i.e. hat, bug.
- *Read phrases and simple sentences.

Mathematics

- *Continue to develop basic counting skills.
- * Continue to develop number sense by using concrete apparatus.
- *Use concrete apparatus to add and subtract and develop associated vocabulary.
- *Find, name and describe 3D shapes.

Physical Development

- *Copy, create and refine motifs in dance.
- *Develop fine motor control through our music, movement and mark making sessions (Write Dance and Dough Dance).
- *Develop an efficient tripod grip and write first names using cursive script.
- *Wake and Shake- S Club 7 Don't Stop Movin'

Topic

- *Name, describe and talk about feelings.
- * Find out about special places around the world linked to our class story.
- *Find, name and describe some common materials and their properties.
- *Design and make items for our story sack using basic shaping and joining skills.
- * Learn songs and simple dances for our rainbow project and Christmas production- 'The Nativity'.
