I (Bertie) have been perfecting armchair snoozes. Peggy thought I had melted.

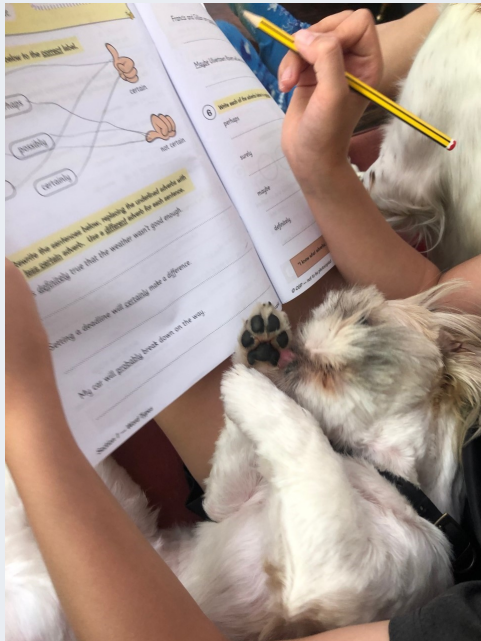
