Week 2: 'It Don't Mean a Thing' by Ella Fitzgerald and Duke Ellington.

Week 3: 'C Jam Blues' by Duke Ellington

Week 4: 'In a Sentimental Mood' by Duke Ellington

- *Wake and Shake- 'La Bamba'.

<u>Art</u>

- *Sort materials by colour and texture.
- *Cut, tear, overlap and stick materials.
- *Create a collage for the art gallery.

Geography

- *Name human and physical (natural) features of a place.
- *Compare a village to a seaside destination.
- *Talk about a place and how it makes us feel.

- *Use cameras and a camera app.
- *Edit photographs.
