WRITE DANCE

A few photographs to show and share what Write Dance looks like in the Nursery. Write Dance is our daily dance program which is designed to develop gross and fine-motor muscle, rhythm, coordination and balance. Every week we learn a new song, dance and then mark make. Above you can see us with our favourite media - paint (including colour mixing), shaving foam and chunky crayons. The dance movements accompany the song lyrics to incorporate a variety of physical actions. This half term we extend our actions and add in our tools e.g. sponges, brushes.

TOPIC

Our topics this term are Spring, Mother's Day and Easter. In our Spring topic we will be talking about the signs of Spring so the children can start to spot them in their environment. During our Mother's day topic, we will be creating some special cards, talking about our mummy using photos to help support us and sharing the funniest stories about them that is always a highlight for us! Our Easter topic will see the return of our Mary and Joseph Russian dolls as we talk about the meaning behind why we celebrate Easter in a child friendly way.
