Additional hours purchased: Should you not be eligible for 2 year old funding, all hours are chargeable at £8.30 per hour (April 2025). (To include hot main meal and pudding, homemade from the school kitchen and staffing). Afternoon snack 50p a day for all 2, 3 and 4 year olds. We are a Registered Childcare Provider for Tax Free Childcare

You can receive up to £500 every 3 months (up to £2,000 a year) for each of your children to help with the costs of childcare. This increases to £1,000 every 3 months if a child is disabled (up to £4,000 a year).

If you receive Tax-Free Childcare, you'll be required to set up an online childcare account for your child. For every £8 you pay into this account, the government will pay in £2 to use to pay your provider
